## **Qualifications and experience:**

- Education: min. Master degree in environment or geography or agronomy or related fields;
- Working experience with international NGOs specialised in rural development or natural resources management;
- Experience in Environment (Biodiversity, climate change issues, Natural Resource Management-NRM, including water resource management...), Agriculture and participatory community development:
- Experience in participatory land use planning will be an asset;
- Knowledge of geographic information system use (QGIS, etc.);
- Experience in coordinating activities set up by a project team, and/or in providing capacity building to technical staff will be an asset;
- Knowledge of participatory approaches will be an asset;
- Ability to work collaboratively with local communities and local government;
- Good knowledge of common computer applications: Windows, Excel, Word;
- · Autonomy, Analytical skills, team spirit;
- Good health and high commitment to working in remote areas;
- Oral and written skills in English is required;

### Main responsibilities:

# Lead the design, implementation and monitoring of the following activities in the province of Phongsaly:

- Participatory Climate Risk and Vulnerability Assessment (PCRVA);
- Dissemination of agro-weather forecast system provided by the Lao Climate Service for Agriculture (LACSA) to farmers;
- Assessment of the risks faced by the local value chains due to climate hazards and economic shocks;
- Assessment of land use and customary practices and identification of village protection forests;
- Design of water source protection plans in closed collaboration with target communities;
- Consultation workshops with the decision-makers at district level on the preservation of water sources:
- Assessment of land use and customary practices and identification of village protection forests;
- Monitoring of local-led initiatives focusing on natural forest protection and afforestation;
- Organisation of concertation & capitalization workshops on environmental and climate change issues in the project target districts.

Support the design, implementation and monitoring of the following activities in the province of Phongsaly:

- Support biodiversity survey data collection in close coordination with the technical assistants, CCL project advisor and biodiversity experts;
- Data management of the Nyot Ou Tea Cooperative in close collaboration with the Cooperative technical team.
